

Previewing the Association of Inhalation Toxicologists 2018 Annual Meeting

The Association of Inhalation Toxicologists will hold its annual meeting October 16-18, 2018 at the Hilton Durham near Duke University in North Carolina, US. The meeting will include presentations, posters and a technology exhibit.

Presentation topics

The agenda will feature topics such as investigating the similarities and differences in inhalation toxicology between the environmental, pharmaceutical, agrochemical and chemical industries; discussions about aerosol characteristics and a session on e-cigarettes.

Posters and exhibitors

Attendees are invited to submit poster abstracts until September 21 on all scientific topics related to inhalation involving new technologies, rodent and/or non-rodent species used in inhalation toxicology, pathology, pharmacology, discovery



and clinical pathology. The meeting will also include ten exhibitors, each of whom will give two-minute presentations as the event begins.

Prior to the meeting, on October 15, participants may attend lectures of The North Carolina Chapter of the Society of Toxicology (NCSOT). The event will take place at the EPA campus in Research Triangle Park and a small additional fee will be charged.
