

Previewing the RDD® Europe 2021 Virtual Conference

Due to COVID-19, Respiratory Drug Delivery (RDD®) Europe 2021 will be presented virtually, May 4-7, 2021, replacing the in-person event originally planned for the same dates in Nice (Antibes), France.

New format will use “knowledge spaces”

For attendees' convenience, instead of using separate spaces or “online rooms” for podium presentations, workshops, posters and exhibitors, RDD Europe 2021 will use a new format called “knowledge spaces.”

Arranged by scientific theme, each knowledge space will merge curated speaker on-demand presentations, workshops, posters and exhibitor content into a single, online location. This can create opportunities for delegates to easily explore given areas of interest (or related topics) with a few mouse clicks.

The organizing committee is also working to maximize interactions and on-screen exposure, using messaging and moderated Q&A sessions in real time. The committee is cur-

rently developing the conference's scientific program and reviewing abstract submissions. Updates will be provided on the RDD Europe 2021 website.

Posters on the Podium

The conference will include “Posters on the Podium (PoP),” for which the RDD reviewers will select posters that feature particularly interesting, important or innovative topics. Every submitted abstract will be considered for PoP.

Supporting next generation scientists

Accepted abstracts from graduate students are automatically eligible for the VCU RDD Peter R. Byron Graduate Student Award of \$1,000.

In addition, graduate students can attend at no charge, provided their academic advisor is registered for the event.

Convenient scheduling

To fit into participants' schedules, live content will be presented for no more than two hours per day and conference content will be available for an extended period after the event.
