Supporting young talent

DDL will also recognize and encourage new talent through multiple awards and activities:

- **Pat Burnell Young Investigator Competition.** Short-listed applicants will deliver a live presentation at DDL2023 and the winner will be announced during the conference.
- **DDL Emerging Scientist Award.** The winner will have demonstrated significant scientific accomplishment or innovation during the early stages of their career in inhalation science (within 15 years from achieving their PhD). The winner will be announced and give a keynote presentation.

- **DDL Career Development Grant** to support new and emerging scientists from public, private and university organizations.
- **New Researcher Network (NRN)**, which aims to develop a broad community of early career scientists, including PhD students, and will host an event during the conference.
